

Shop Hop Layout for 20 blocks

Quilt size: 52" x 62"

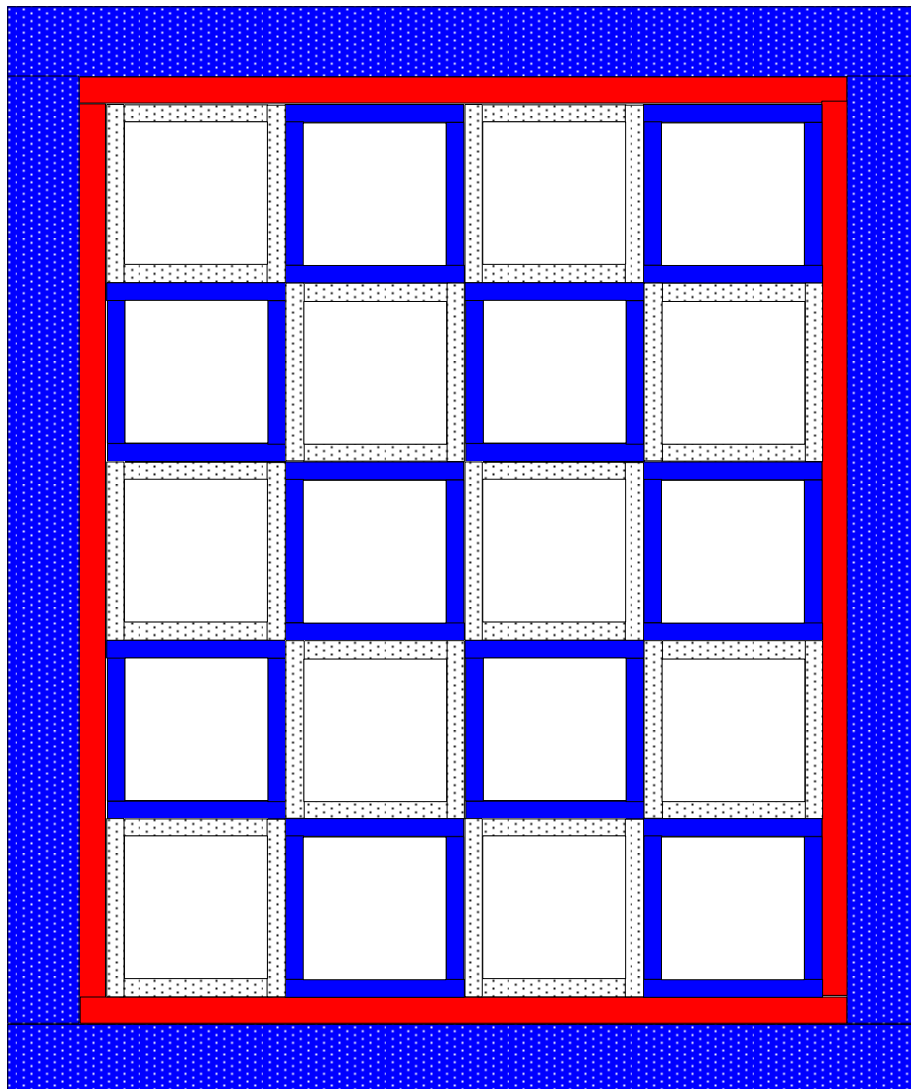
Border Fabric **1 yard**
Cut 6 strips, 5" x 42"

Frame Accent 1 (White dots) **3/4 yd.**
Cut 1 strip, 8 1/2" x 42", crosscut into 20 segments, 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
Cut 1 strip, 10 1/2" x 42", crosscut into 20 segments, 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Frame Accent 2 (Blue) **3/4 yd.**
Cut 1 strip, 8 1/2" x 42", crosscut into 20 segments, 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
Cut 1 strip, 10 1/2" x 42", crosscut into 20 segments, 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Inner Border (Red) **1/2 yd.**
Cut 6 strips, 2" x 42"

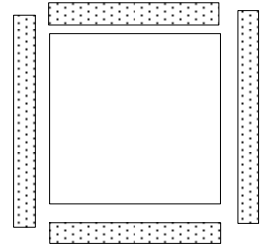
Binding **1/2 yd.**
Cut 6 strips, 2 1/2" x 42"



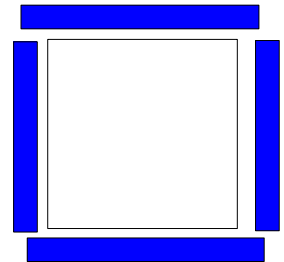
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Piecing:

1. Divide the blocks into two piles, one pile for the Accent 1 frames and one pile for the Accent 2 frames.
2. Sew the 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Accent 1 segments to the top and bottom of the block. Then sew the 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Accent 1 segments to the sides of the block. Make 10



3. Sew the 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Accent 2 segments to the sides of the block. Then sew the 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Accent 2 segments to the top and bottom of the block. Make 10



4. Sew the blocks together as shown in the diagram. Alternating the blocks and having 4 blocks across by 5 blocks down. See page 1.

Inner Border

1. Cut two 2" Inner border strips in half and sew one long strip and one short strip together using a diagonal seam. Make 4.
2. Measure down the middle of the quilt top for the side border measurement. Cut two inner border strips to this measurement. Pin both ends of the border to the ends of the quilt top and match the middle of the border strip to the middle of the side. Ease or stretch to make the border fit the quilt top. Sew the borders on using a 1/4" seam allowance and press the borders to the inner border strip.
3. Measure across the middle of the quilt top for the top and bottom border measurement and attach these borders the same as the side borders.

Outer Border

Repeat the same process as for the Inner Border.
